Student Qualifications for application:

- Must be a sophomore in high school
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (non-weighted)
- Must have completed Alg II & Biology I or be co-enrolled Junior Year
- Taken the National ACT Test (recommended) or the RRTC Academy Assessment (more details at bottom of this page.)
- Proficient in utilizing computer and basic office software

RETURN your application packet with the following items to your SCHOOL COUNSELOR:

Completed Student Application (2 pages)

- Signed by both applicant and parent/guardian
- Schedule preference (AM or PM) indicated
- Resume (optional)
- Red River 2018-19 high school enrollment form

Student Paragraph Responses

- Student name and sending school located in header

Teacher Recommendation Forms – each form submitted in sealed envelope with teacher's signature across the seal and applicant's name clearly labeled on envelope.

- Teacher from a core subject area

Counselor Form

- ACT Scores & Official Transcript (3 semester)

Completed Biomedical Science Academy Application Packet and all related documentation must be received in the Admissions Office at Red River Technology Center by:

3:00 pm on Tuesday, April 3, 2018

Alternative Assessment:

Your ACT scores are required as part of the application & you can obtain ACT scores by:

1. Taking the **National ACT** Assessment (Recommended). The next ACT will be **February 10, 2018**, but you have to register by **January 12, 2018**, or there is a late registration fee.
2. Taking the **Application Assessment** at Red River Technology Center. If you have not (or cannot) take the ACT and receive your scores before the Application Deadline on **April 3, 2018**, you can take an Application Assessment at RRTC. The scores will **only count at RRTC**. There is **no fee charged** for taking the test.
