Prepare for a career as a licensed cosmetologist through hands-on training in a state-of-the-art salon environment. Students study hair, nails and skin care to prepare for the Oklahoma State Board of Cosmetology exam.

The Cosmetologist career major is a two-year, part-time program open only to high school juniors age 16 and older.
